Ceramic mineral granule in bulk. Mineral chippings are commonly used as a surface finish for flat or lowpitched roofs, particularly those made of bitumen. These chippings are made from crushed natural slate. The chippings are applied to the surface of the roof as a protective layer that helps to prevent damage from UV rays, extreme temperatures, and weathering. They also provide a non-slip surface that makes it safer to walk on the roof for maintenance or repairs. In addition to their functional benefits, mineral chippings can also enhance the aesthetic appearance of a roof, as they come in a range of colors and sizes that can be used to create different patterns or designs.
