


## **Drawing Notes:**

Insulation boards should always be installed in a staggered, brick-like pattern. This layout reduces the risk of thermal inefficiency due to cold bridging effects.

Any secondary layers of insulation should follow this same principal, but board joints should be offset as illustrated.
